## **Metro Transit Operators with ATU Local 1005 to Speak Out About ICE Actions Impacting Metro Transit**

MINNEAPOLIS – On Wednesday, January 14, at 11:00 a.m., members and leaders of Amalgamated Transit Union (ATU) Local 1005 who make Metro Transit run will speak out near the site where a bus driver saw a Minnesotan grabbed by ICE agents last week.

Members will share other awful examples of how ICE is impacting their ability to do their job. They will speak about the need for ICE to not interfere with transit operations so that Minnesotans can be safe in transit within their own community.
