**Postal Workers with Building a Fighting NALC to Hold Rally and March**  
Demanding ICE Off Postal Property, ICE Out of MN, and Justice for Renee Good

MINNEAPOLIS – On Sunday, January 18 at 11:00 a.m., Twin Cities-based members of Building a Fighting National Association of Letter Carriers (BFN) will be joined by community supporters to rally and march at the Lake Street Post Office where ICE agents have been seen staging operations since early December 2025.

Postal workers with BFN will share how ICE is impacting their ability to do their job. They will speak on their demands for ICE to stay off postal property and for charging the ICE agent who murdered Renee Good.

**WHAT:** Postal workers with Building a Better NALC will rally, share ICE's impact on their work, and BFN's demands followed by a march with supporters
